

Easter Egg Hunt Score Study

Cut out each egg and place them inside of a plastic Easter egg. Place the eggs around your studio. When the student is ready to learn a new piece, allow the student to hunt for them and answer each question as they find and open the egg.

Where do your hands go? How do you know?

What is the first note in the bass clef?

What is the first note in the treble clef?

How many beats are in a measure?

What measure looks like it will be hardest to play?

What questions do you have about the music?

Do you see any measures that happen more than once?

Highlight all of the dynamics in your piece.

Find a step up and a step down in the music.

Find a skip up and a skip down in the music.

Find any repeated notes.

What is the mood or style of the piece?
