

Easter Eggs

FOR FINGER INDEPENDENCE

Chances are your young students will need extra practice moving their fingers independently from each other.

- Print these eggs on colored cardstock and laminate.
 - Grab a dice and 5 coins or buttons.
- Place a coin at the start of each line to the left of the egg.
 - The student rolls the die to determine which finger they use to move a coin along a line. Do this until the student has rolled and moved coins with fingers 1-5. If they roll a 6 or a repeat number, they roll again.
- Repeat the same process with the left hand once all of the coins have made it to the right side.

Try again with a new egg!
